

Combined NAS Training and Historic Shipwreck Diving Course

The course will take place on St Mary's in the Isles of Scilly. The Isles of Scilly are situated 28 miles west of Lands Ends, Cornwall. Scilly consists of 150 islands, rocks and outcrops with only five inhabited islands, all popular holiday destinations each with its own special character. St Mary's has the largest population and has numerous pubs, restaurants, shops, hotels, B&B's and a large campsite. Set in idyllic surroundings, there is so much to see and do once the diving is over.



The course will be a mix of diving on historic wrecks and classroom instruction. Mornings will be devoted to diving. All diving will be from **Tiburón**, a local dive charter boat. **Tiburón** is a comfortable 35 ft offshore 105. You will get a chance to dive some of the many historic wreck sites in Scilly including **Colossus**, Bartholomew Ledges, **Eagle** (Tearing Ledge), **Firebrand**, **Association** and many others. You will also have the chance to participate in ongoing survey work on some of these wrecks.



Afternoons will be spent on dry land, with a mixture of classroom and practical survey sessions. The course will be taught by Kevin Camidge, freelance maritime archaeologist and licensee of **Colossus**, Richard Larn, shipwreck historian and author and Dave McBride, local boat skipper, commercial diver and underwater photographer.

Course dates: Sunday 13th to Friday 18th July 2008

Price: £310 per person (9 students)

Students must be at least BSAC sport diver or equivalent.



This includes all tuition for the NAS Introduction and Part I courses, one year's membership of NAS and six days' hard boat diving onboard **Tiburón**. Dive air is NOT included (about £21 for the week), transport to Scilly (ferry, helicopter or fixed wing aircraft) and accommodation on Scilly.
